Monthly Meeting

Meeting called to order at 7:05 p.m.

Meeting started with Lynn Wheeler reporting her research of Powder House Hill in Haverhill and provided an in depth report to the Commission.

Some of the things that need to be researched are Town Records on all burials at Powder House Hill and if all those individuals were actually removed to another cemetery. Several deeds surrounding Powder House Hill mention the burying ground. There appears to be a need to do an in depth research at the Registry of Deeds concerning the actual property lines. Another matter is the Right of Way from Route #10. Research needs to be completed with the State of NH and their survey records that are most likely archived in Concord.

Haverhill Historical Society is very concerned about the Petition to sell Powder House Hill as Powder House Hill appears to be very rich in early Haverhill history that should not be forgotten.

Caboose: Will need to speak with Liz Shelton about moving the Caboose to the other side of the old Railroad Station (now known at the Party Store and Everything But the Cook). Need to determine the actual property lines. Commission Members did visit the Caboose and walked the area on Feb. 4th. Key to the Caboose has been obtained and able to inspect the inside.

Hazen Park: Need to do some work to get logs and brush removed. Needs to look into signage to let folks know where the house, barn, corn crib, etc., were located.

Mill Street Bridge: The State will be meeting in April in regards to the Mill Street Bridge. Numerous people are served by this bridge. State will embed a sign into the cement as to the history of this bridge.

Minutes of January 26th Monthly Meeting: Wayne moved and Everett seconded, approved.

Treasurer: Wayne provided a copy of the January 1, 2017 Savings Statement. Currently there is \$2,457.16 in the account. Everett Sawyer, Chairperson and Evelyn Elms, Treasurer need to go to the bank and have their names added to the account and any former names removed.
