Welcome to Fred Garofalo, Haverhill Selectboard.

Fred spoke about history in general, Hazen Park and Powder House Hill.

Everett reviewed the three parcels (Hazen Park, Railroad Park and Powder House Hill. Everett has paperwork on how to get these on the State Registry.

Reviewed maps on Powder House Hill. Discussion. Commission should have Powder House Hill lot surveyed out and need to get an estimate on cost.

Discussion about a building at the Grafton County Farm. It is not in good shape – decided we won't engage in taking possession.

House in Haverhill Corner that contains the old jail. Need to encourage owner to keep jail as is.

Sue Hehre has offered her house for a fundraiser.

Motion made to change the Heritage Commission from a Savings Account to a checking account by Mike, seconded by Everett and approved with Everett and Bunny as signatures.

Fred Garofalo will be the Selectboard Representative and Wayne Fortier to stay on as a member.

Discussion about involving Haverhill Historical Society to list places on National Register of historical sites. The State only prepares ten (10) markers per year and has a waiting list. Would request Hazen Park and Powder House Hill be placed on that list.

Hazen Park: Already had two (2) burns and need a third. Mike suggested putting up Story Boards – Discussion. Mike suggested having a Town Pot Luck Picnic lunch. Need to give the two couples mowing, etc. a gift certificate.

Caboose: Meeting at the Woodsville Guaranty Savings Bank and moving Caboose. Liz Shelton asked about selling the caboose. Erin would like a cooking school using the caboose. There is no problem with moving. Check with Robco if it could be picked up gently and moved. Discussion. At this point, no to selling and cooking school. Mike suggested moving ahead with place to move caboose. Contact Dick Eckwild to evaluate caboose and fixing. Memorial Blocks and RR light to be erected. Check with mason, Daryl Hamlett. Wayne Fortier has the original key to the Caboose. Copies to be made for Commission Members.
