ATV and OHRV use

Timeline of Events

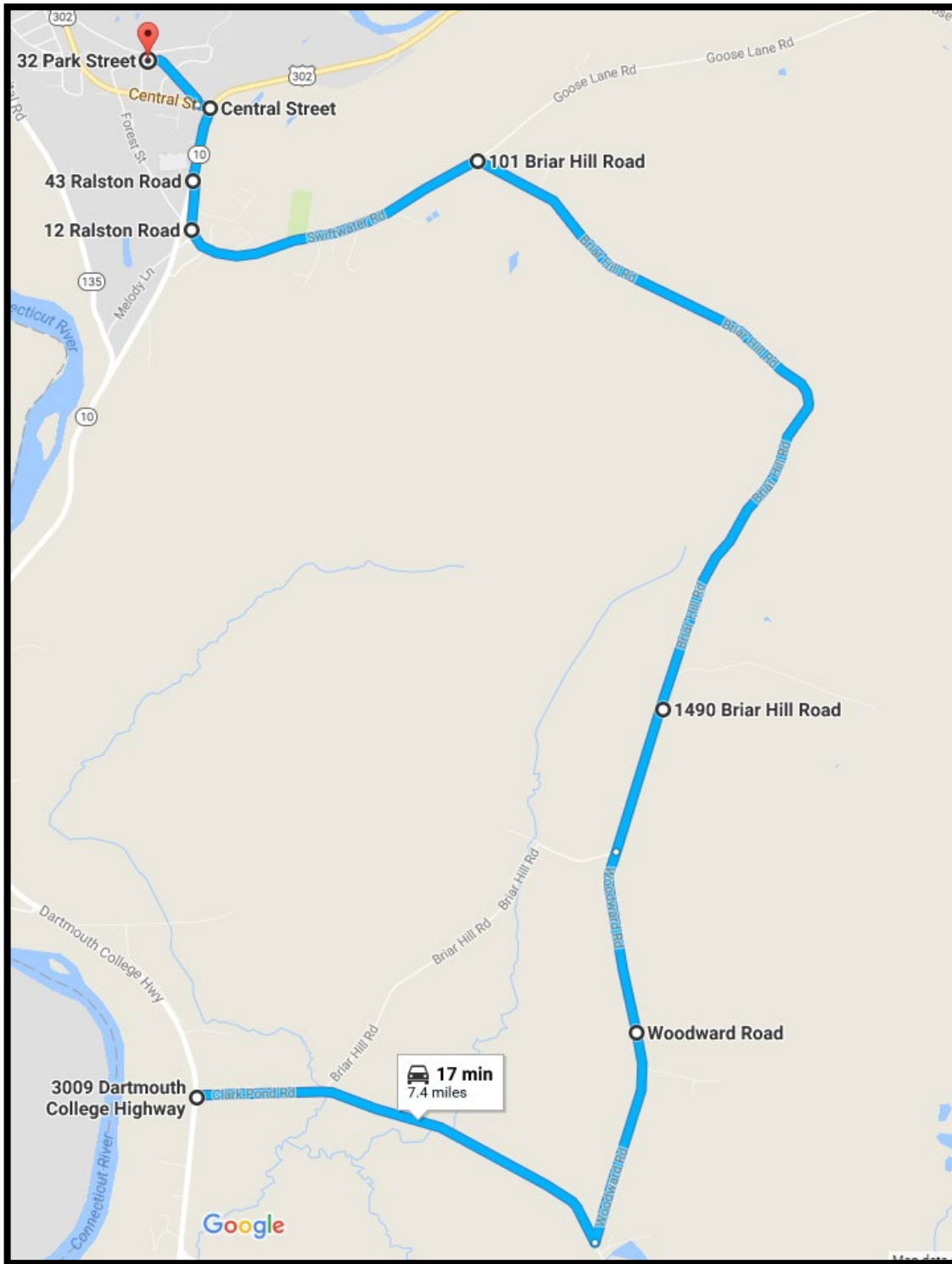
1. **March 27, 2021** - MLD Warrant Article 18: To see if the district will petition the Town of Haverhill to allow the use of OHRV's (ATV's, Side by sides) on all roads within the district boundaries. The petition should include that the district, if granted, understands all State of NH ATV rules and regulations will be implemented and followed. (Passed)
2. **May 3, 2021** – Select Board held a public hearing on ATV/OHRV access on Mountain Lakes roads.
3. **May 9, 2021** – Deadline for written testimony for the Select Board's consideration on ATV/OHRV access on Mountain Lakes roads.
4. **May 10, 2021** – Select Board voted to open Augies-by-Pass for the ATV season.
5. **May 25, 2021** – Select Board voted not to open the Blackmount Trail to ATV traffic.
6. **May 25, 2021** – Select Board voted to open Morse Road, Tewksbury Road, and all roads in Mountain Lakes to ATV / OHRV traffic from May 23, 2021, though October 1, 2021, on a trial basis.
7. **November 8, 2021** – Select Board voted to make permanent the ATV seasonal use during daylight hours (half hour before sunrise to half-hour after sunset) May 23 to October 31 on the upper part of Morse Road, on Tewksbury Road, and on all Mt. Lakes roads.

Local Regulations

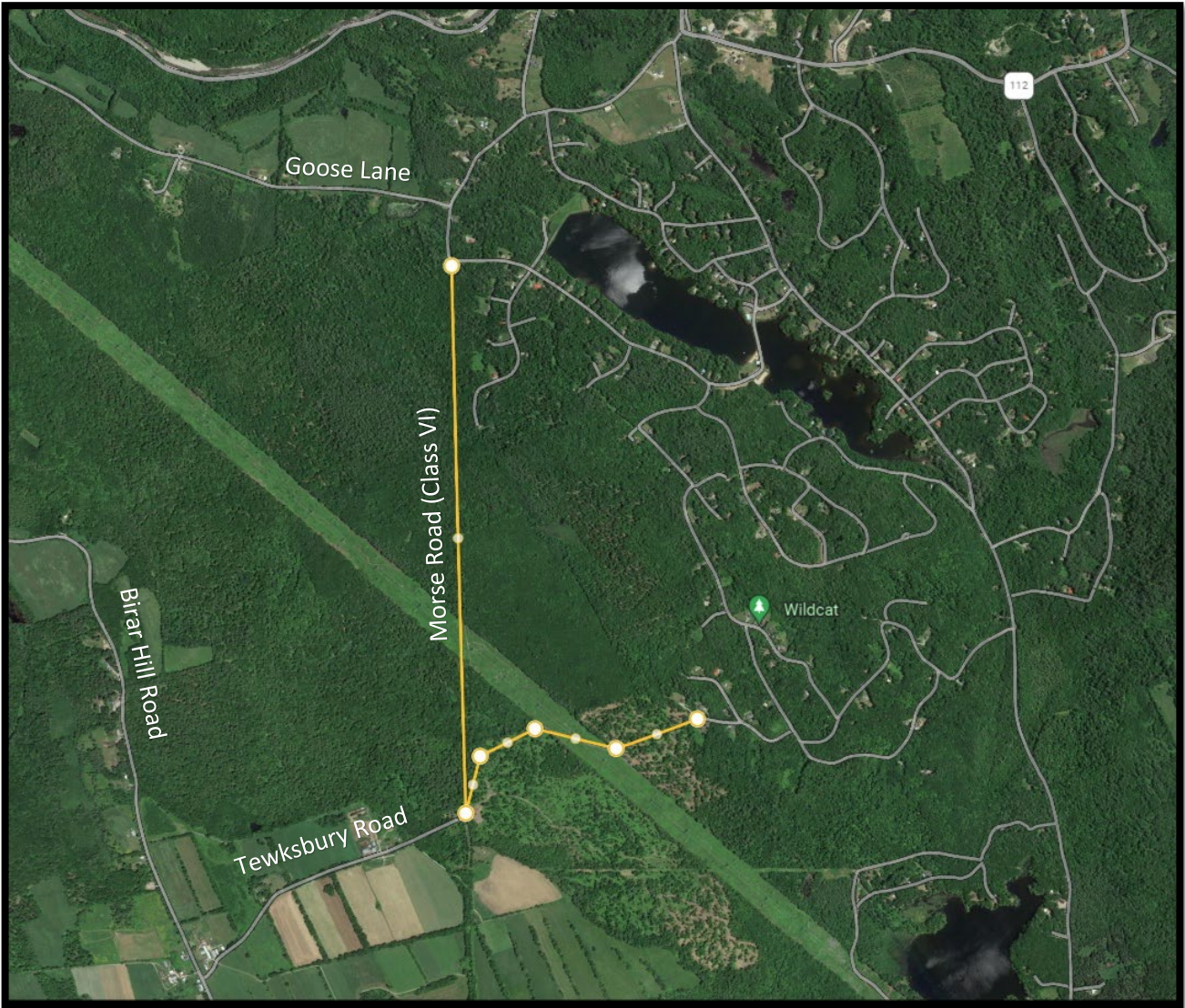
- A. On Augies-by-Pass ATV / OHRV are allowed during the day and after dark with a headlight and taillight per State Regulations May 23rd through October 31st each year.
- B. On upper part of Morse Road, Tewksbury Road, and Mountain Lakes Roads ATV / OHRV use is allowed one-half hour before sunrise and one-half hour after sunset from May 23rd through October 31st each year.
- C. All ATV / OHRV use must be in accordance with State of NH Rules & Regulations.

Enforcement

- I. ATV / OHRV use on any Town of Haverhill Road may be enforced by the Town of Haverhill Police Department or NH Fish and Game Department.
- II. ATV / OHRV use on any trail shall be enforced by the NH Fish and Game Department.
