

TOWN ORDINANCE


TOWN OF HAVERHILL, NEW HAMPSHIRE  
Effective January 11, 2000

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Haverhill Board of Selectmen by NHRSA 41:11, the Board hereby issues the following regulations for the use of public highways and sidewalks in the Town of Haverhill:


1. Whoever shall double-park a vehicle on a public highway so as to impede the free flow of traffic, shall pay a fine of \$25.00.
2. Whoever shall block or obstruct a public way, a driveway, or the entrance to a parking lot, with a motor vehicle, shall pay a fine of \$25.00.
3. Whoever shall park a motor vehicle on the wrong side of the street against the normal flow of traffic, shall pay a fine of \$25.00.
4. Whoever shall park or drive a motor vehicle on a sidewalk, except in case of emergency, shall pay a fine of \$25.00.
5. Whoever shall place a motor vehicle in a clearly designated unloading zone for any purpose other than unloading merchandise shall pay a fine of \$25.00.
6. Whoever shall park a motor vehicle in violation of the parking ban during snow removal shall pay a fine of \$25.00.
7. Whoever shall park a motor vehicle, not exhibiting Handicap License plates, in a Handicap Parking Stall shall pay a fine of \$75.00.
8. Whoever shall use the public ways and sidewalks for skateboards, roller skates, ball playing, kite flying, or any similar amusement or other practice and in so doing shall interfere with or annoy pedestrians using the sidewalks or properly registered motor vehicles or bicycles using the public ways, shall pay a fine not to exceed \$200.00.


