Hazen Park: Mr. Roberts Brooks & Mr. Bill Jacobs have been mowing and their wives tending to flower beds. Mr. Brooks will be leaving in Sept. and not coming back next year. Commission will put on a picnic Saturday, July 22nd at 1:00 at Hazen Park to recognize their contributions. It was also voted to give both Mr. Brooks and Mr. Jacobs a \$100 gift certificate to the Happy Hour Restaurant. A granite stone at the house has cracked and needs to be stabilized. Brush work needs to be done – fall work.
