Members from the public (Open time for public discussion) - Guests: Grete D'Hondt, Beth O'Connor

Moonlight Kayak July 31<sup>st</sup> – on Friday the 31<sup>st</sup> the HARP children would make votives. Remember to have the kayaks washed. Request to have it advertised on the radio. Mtn. Lakes has a wash station set up. Last year we supplied the 'smares' – there will be a bonfire, mike system available for music. 'Blue Moon' Friday at 7. They would love to have some volunteers. Grete will give us flyers for the HARP children and families. Mtn. Lakes have the movie license and projector and offered that the Commission could use at the Lodge. (This was discussed with the Mt. Lakes Commissioners and it was approved that we could have a joint venture). Turkey Plunge – unanimous that the Mountain Lakes residents and renters are able to participate in the Recreation Commission events and that the Turkey Plunge would be our sole fundraiser.

Approval of minutes: Lynn/Kim motion made to approve the minutes

Old Business:

1. Directors report – Surveys were sent out to the Middle School – only 2 returned –they were in favor of an Adventure Camp to include hiking, geocaching, + Railroad Park Concert –Phil 'n the Blanks' was scheduled for 6/28 – raining and had to move to the Clifford Building – only 22 people attended – concern and discussion of consistent nights for concerts for next year, what venues to 'advertise' – there was ample time to notice and advertise 'switch' to Clifford Building. Lynn and Steve ran the concessions. Signs were out. Put poll on FB – out of 200 only 14 didn't know where Clifford building was and 5 out of 126 did not know where pool is.  
HARP – 30 children/day average; top 36, 2 new children today. Went to Whale's Tail last Thursday, tie-dyed shirts Wednesday (incident with shirts – HARP kids pick up the Armory – only thing left in Great room - two white bags of the shirts. The building was rented for an event on Saturday – went in Friday night and the renter threw them away and the renters even asked to have the dumpster taken away \$10.50/shirt - \$457 + cost of t-shirts. Renter will pay for what he threw away - \$15/shirt. Grete mentioned that they tie die themselves and less money. Town will be reimbursed and the shirts will be redone Wednesday, July 8<sup>th</sup>. Going to Echo Lake this Friday.  
Pool - Open House on the 21<sup>st</sup>. Raining and Pouring – not well attended. Bob Fagnant ran the grill; Cindy donated the time with 60 people throughout the day. Front of building was painted. Bob repaired the roof, Lynn and Steve replaced a beam. Small leak above the counter.  
Baseball & Softball camp this week – 31 attendees Mon – Wed. with Willie Kingsbury.  
British Soccer – 23 registered so far at end of August. 1 confirmed host family.

Muster - tug of war, bucket brigade, (4 five gallon buckets – cups) – 20 participants so far, obstacle course, knock down bottles with water spicket. 3 legged,  
A volunteer purchased 20 prizes – fireman cloth backpacks, fireman badges, little trophies.  
Lynn, Cindy, Sherri, Kim, Jo said they could commit to running the ‘Kids Muster’ on the 8<sup>th</sup>.

New Business:

1. Haverhill Recreation Tent Discussion – tent is down and stored. Concern to be sure it is dismantled in time. Letter is requested to Selectboard to ask & confirm storage for 2016.
2. Conniption Fits – July 19 concert – Jo available – others?
3. Commission asked to come up with some estimates to repair the roof at the pool building. Lynn and Cindy confirmed the Cohase Lions approval to help us fix the roof as this is a community entity that their fundraising would support. There were asked to come up with some estimates to present with costs to upgrade to 2” x 8”s, continuous beams, steel roof. Once estimates are presented then they would approach the Cohase Lions for funding.
