

## Generator and Property Assessment and Taxes Policy

A generator that backs up a residential home primary power system provides desirable cost savings and emergency support to both those who reside in the home and town emergency services. Having a generator on hand, should primary power go out, means that savings come back to the resident and the town through the value of safety, security and convenience.

As an incentive to homeowners and the Town of Haverhill to better prepare for power outage emergencies that require back-up power, the Haverhill Selectboard resolves not to include the value of a generator that backs up a residential primary power system as an improvement or contributing factor associated with the value of assessed property and subsequently, the property tax.




