CAMPING ON PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY OR PUBLIC PROPERTY POLICY

RSA 236:58 states that “no person shall pitch a tent or place or erect any other camping device or sleep on the ground within the public right-of-way or on public property unless permission is received from the governing board of the governmental authority having jurisdiction over such public right-of-way or property.”

Any person or persons who wish to camp within the public right-of-way or on public property within the Town of Haverhill shall come before the Board of Selectmen or their designee(s) to request such permission. Each request for permission shall be presented in writing to the Board of Selectmen or their designee(s) to include specific dates and times. At no time shall permission be granted for more than three (3) consecutive days.

Per RSA 236:59, any person or persons who fail to request permission of the Board of Selectmen or their designee(s), shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, in addition, shall be liable for the cost of restoration for any damage caused. All applicable penalties are determined by the relevant statute.

If at any time that state law changes, it is the governing law.


