On January 23, 2023, the Haverhill Police Department arrested 54yo Stephen Baker of North Haverhill, NH for Reckless Conduct-Deadly Weapon, Criminal Threatening-Deadly Weapon, Criminal Threatening- Conduct, 3 charges of Resisting Arrest/Detention, and 3 charges of Disorderly Conduct. Baker was held at the Grafton County House of Correction until he was arraigned the following day. He is currently being held on preventative detention.
